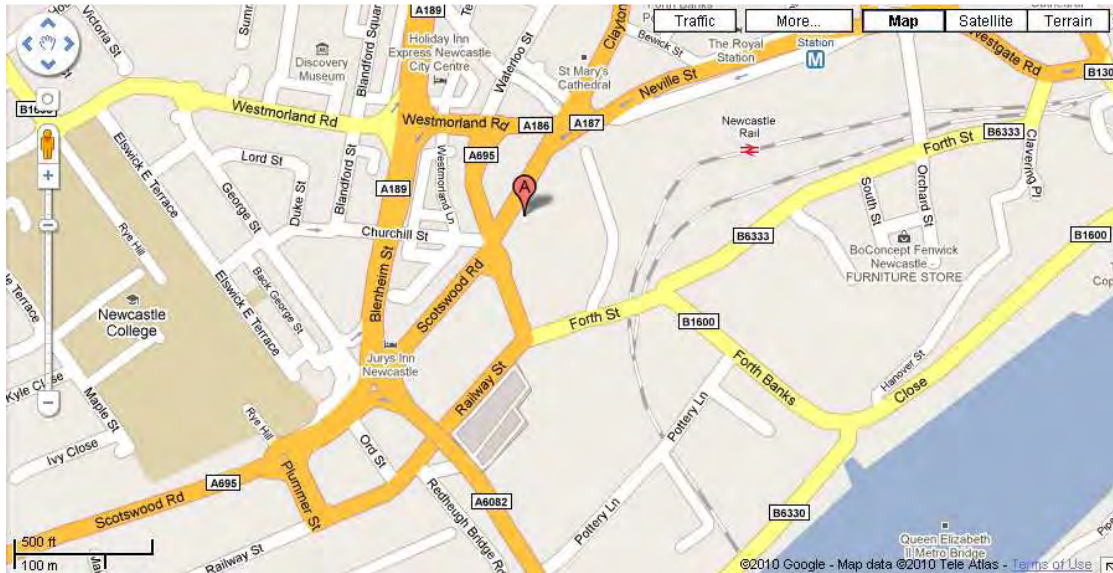

From the A1

Take the exit onto the A184 (Gateshead & Newcastle Centre). Keeping to the right hand lane, cross the River Tyne on the Redheugh Bridge. Get into the left hand lane when on the bridge and take the slip road to the left at the end of the bridge (before the road curves to the right). Stay in the left hand lane and turn left at the roundabout. Go past Times Square car park and get into the right hand lane at the traffic lights. Go straight across the traffic lights and turn left into the Centre for Life. If the security barrier is lowered, call security using the intercom at the barrier. The Conference and Banqueting Suite is approximately 50m up on the left hand side.

Walking from Central Station

Come out of the station and turn left. Continue walking for approximately 150m and you will arrive at the Centre for Life. You will see a glass bridge joining the two halves of the building. Do not walk under here but instead turn left and walk down the left side of the building. You will pass the entrance to the Institute of human Genetics on your right hand side. The Conference and Banqueting Suite is approximately 50m down this road on the right hand side.
