Public Engagement and Outreach Bursary
Terms & Conditions

- The maximum amount that can be awarded for an RMS Public Engagement and Outreach Bursary is £100
- Bursaries can be awarded for both in person and virtual activities and events.
- The decision of the Executive Honorary Secretary and Honorary Secretary (Education) is final and applications will not be reconsidered once a decision has been made.
- To be eligible for a Bursary you must have been a member of the RMS for a minimum of one year at the time of application. This can be verified by the RMS Office.
- If a candidate is successful in their application, they must submit an outreach event report to the RMS. The decision of whether to publish it in **infocus** magazine is at the discretion of the RMS.
- Payment will be made after the outreach event, on completing an RMS Expense Form and producing the relevant receipts and report, the deadline for this being 30 days after the date of the outreach event.
- Only in exceptional circumstances will the Society fund more than one bursary per member/Fellow in any financial year (January to December).
