Application for an RMS Travel Bursary

As a means of encouraging our members to attend conferences, both within the UK and also overseas, Council has set aside a special bursary fund for this specific purpose. If you have been a member of the Royal Microscopical Society for more than one year at the time of application and have been accepted to present a paper involving microscopy at a conference or workshop, either orally or as a poster, you are eligible to apply for support from this fund.

The following points should be noted:

- So that the maximum number of awards can be made in one year, we will limit the amounts to a maximum of
 - £125 for a meeting up to 300km away from your place of work
 - £200 for a meeting 300-2000km away from your place of work
 - £300 for a meeting over 2000km away from your place of work
- It is anticipated that where these sums are insufficient to cover all costs of attending a meeting, they will be used as 'leverage' for additional support from elsewhere.
- After the conference the member will prepare a short report for publication in *infocus*.
